Authorizes a regional or local agency that is a lead agency for a project or project component for which bond funding has been programmed or otherwise approved by the administrative agency or is otherwise targeted to be available to apply to the agency for a letter of no prejudice that would make the agency eligible to be subsequently reimbursed from bond funds for expenditures of funds under its control for the project or project component under certain conditions.

Prohibits a state official, including the Governor, from binding the state to provisions of a Proposed International Trade Agreement, including the government procurement rules, unless a statute is enacted that authorizes such official to bind the state or to give consent to bind the state to that agreement.
