Special Screening of "The Wonder of it All"

A new, innovative documentary explores the impact space exploration has made on the lives of seven of the twelve astronauts who walked on the moon. It focuses on the "rarely told human side of the men behind the Apollo missions to the Moon," added the film's Executive Producer/Director Jeffrey Roth. "This film weaves the astronauts' insightful interviews with rarely seen private family photos and NASA archival footage to poignantly tell their unique story in their own words." Described by NBC News Space Analyst James Oberg as having "seamless editing" with a narrative that is "absolutely perfect," it is not surprising that the film took "Winner – Special Jury Award for Documentary from Worldfest, and won Second Place at the Rhode Island International Film Festival. The film delves into the lives and experiences of former astronauts Buzz Aldrin, Alan Bean, Edgar Mitchell, Harrison Schmitt, Charles Duke, Eugene Cernan, and John Young, and took over two and a half years to produce.

California Space Authority (CSA) Media/PR Manager, Wil Simon noted, "Roth's documentary is a compelling, humanistic story, about how each man was affected in a unique way by walking on the surface of the moon. People love to know what makes a pioneer "tick" and this film offers a unique perspective on these men.

From the South

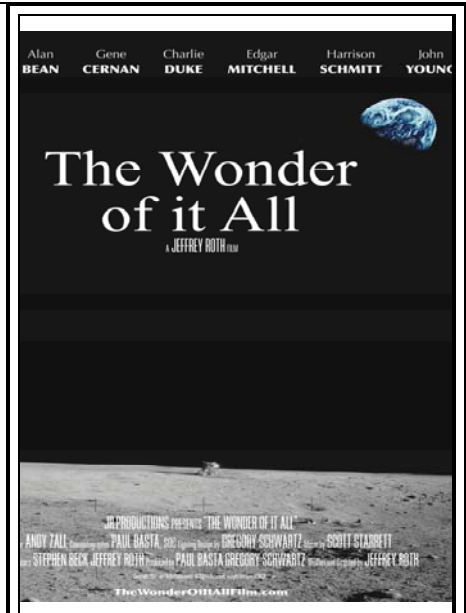
Take Hwy. 101 N.
